SCOPE OF THE COMPETITION:

Part One (prior to competition): Teams will be required to paint <u>two</u> 18" x 24" flat sheet metal panels. One panel should be basecoat/clearcoat color only. The second panel should be a custom painted panel using a basecoat/clearcoat system. The students will also be required to provide a picture portfolio for each panel showing the different steps and provide his/her own display system.

Part Two (on-site): The contestant will be required to repair a fender at the State Fair using basic hand tools. The fender will be prepped for the application of 2K Primer.

SAFETY STATEMENT:

All entries must present at registration, the attached Safety Statement signed by students and advisors. Safety glasses required.

NUMBER OF CONTESTANTS:

This is a two-member team competition.

Part One: The first team member will complete the paint project at his home school, present the project using the picture photos in a maximum of one-minute presentation explaining the procedure used in finishing the panels.

Part Two: The second team member will complete the sheet metal repairs at the State Fair. Schools may enter a first year team only, a second year team only, or a first and second year team. Each school can enter two teams.

AWARDS: Three awards will be presented at the contest area.

- 1. Part 1: First, Second and Third Display of panels pre-produced
- 2. Part 2: First, Second and Third On-site panel
- 3. Combined: First, Second and Third for Overall

ENTRY FEE: \$40.00 per team entering the competition. (\$20.00 per contestant) The registration must be accompanied by a check. Please register on-line at <u>www.skillsusava.org</u>, go to Event, State Fair and then to Competitions.

DEADLINE: Schools must register the number of teams by September 15, 2023. Contestant names must be submitted to the by September 15, 2023. Substitutions may be made the day of the competition.

- <u>Participants must have a Student Competition Ticket to enter the Fairgrounds unless they are already at the Fair for another competition.</u>
- <u>Teachers are responsible for ordering tickets online directly from the State Fair Ticket Office using a State Fair</u> <u>Student Competition Ticket Order link, which can be found on-line at www.skillsusava.org</u> under 'State Fair'
- State Fair tickets MUST be ordered online so everyone may enter near contest site. (Gate 2) You will be allowed to park in this area with advance tickets. No picking up tickets on site.
