- Brakes
- Scan Tool
- 2 or 3 Electrical Testing and Analysis Stations
- Measurements
- Component ID with resource information provided
- Written Safety Test Possible

## NUMBER OF CONTESTANTS:

The first 24 Chapters to submit the registration form will be permitted to enter one team of two contestants per school. You may sign up a second team after the deadline on a first come first

serve basis to fill the maximum of 24 team slots. Registrations will be dated as received to determine the second teams invited to fill any space that is available.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented at the Contest Area.

### **SAFETY FORM:**

Each contestant must turn in a signed SkillsUSA Virginia Safety Form to the competition chairman on the day of the competition. Each contestant is responsible for bringing the proper PPE to wear while participation in the contest.

- **ENTRY FEE:** \$40.00 per team entering the competition. (\$20. Per contestant) The registration must be accompanied by a check. Please register on-line at <u>www.skillsusava.org</u>, go to Event, State Fair and then to Competitions.
- **DEADLINE:** Schools must register the number of teams by September 15, 2023. Contestants must register by September 15, 2023. Substitutions may be made the day of the competition.
  - Participants must have a Student Competition Ticket to enter the Fairgrounds unless they are already at the Fair for another competition.
  - Teachers are responsible for ordering tickets online directly from the State Fair Ticket Office using a State Fair Student Competition Ticket Order link, which can be found on-line at www.skillsusava.org under 'State Fair'
  - State Fair Tickets MUST be purchased online so everyone may enter near contest site (GATE 2) You will be allowed to park in this area with advance tickets. No picking up tickets on site.
