SCOPE OF THE COMPETITION: The time allotted is 12 minutes per station, with a three minute break/rotation. All teams from the same school will be competing together at the same time. Judges lunch break at approximately 12:00 p.m.

The stations will be as follows:

Station 1 – Identify Refrigeration System Components

Station 2 – "Troubleshooting" - A/C Window unit

Station 3 – Refrigeration System Servicing - Practical and Q&A.

Station 4 – "Troubleshooting" - Refrigeration System

Station 5 – "Troubleshooting" - Split System

Station 6 - Teamwork Copper Project (see ** below)

JUDGING CRITERIA: * for stations 2, 4 & 5

Judging Criteria: Accuracy, Appearance, Leak Test and TEAMWORK=10 Points each (Total points= 40)

Allotted Time = 15 Minutes

(**AGAIN THIS YEAR) Practice Flaring and Swaging before the contest.
Using 3/8" and ½" soft copper tubing

Practice materials will not be provided.

TOOL DROP OFF: Tools boxes maybe dropped off near the contest site. Walk to will call to pick up and pay for preordered fair tickets.

DEBRIEFING: To take place directly after the conclusion of the contest. Judges at each event station will provide contest information to teams dealing with items including; troubleshooting problems, technical tips, advise, concerns and positive feed back.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented at the Contest Area.

NUMBER OF CONTESTANTS: Each school can enter up to three (3) - teams of two.

Max of 18 teams for this event.

DEADLINE: Schools must register the number of teams by September 15, 2023. Contestant names must be submitted to the State SkillsUSA Specialist by September 15, 2023. Substitutions may be made the day of the competition.

ENTRY FEE: \$40.00 per team entering the competition. The registration must be accompanied by a check. Please register on-line at www.skillsusava.org, go to Event, State Fair and then to Competitions.

- Participants must have a Student Competition Ticket to enter the Fairgrounds unless they are already at the Fair for another competition.
- Teachers are responsible for ordering tickets online by September 20, 2023 directly from the State Fair Ticket Office using a State Fair Student Competition Ticket Order link, which can be found on-line at www.skillsusava.org under 'State Fair'
- Tool drop off, schools must have a 30 min. drop pass for vehicle entry, or contestants will have to carry in their tool boxes to the contest area. Passes maybe ordered when ordering State Fair tickets.

<u>Safety Notice</u>: Each contestant is responsible for bringing the proper PPE to wear while participation in the contest. Also, each contestant must turn in a signed SkillsUSA Safety Form to the competition chairman on the day of the competition.
