NOTE: ALL contest are subject to increased difficulty levels from previous state competitions in order to align the scope and skill level to that of National Competitions.

- Contestants should report approximately 30 minutes early to the contest site with their name tag turned so that their contestant number is showing.

### Clothing

Official SkillsUSA light blue or khaki work shirt or SkillsUSA Virginia State Conference t-shirt) and navy pants or work pants, black or brown leather (OSHA compliant) work shoes.

Contestants are **Required** to have proof of OSHA 10 Certification prior to competition.

### **Tools and Equipment**

Supplied by the contestant:

- a. One pair of plastic or rubber gloves with three-quarter sleeves
- b. Hearing protection devices
- c. All competitors must create a one-page
