

SkillsUSA Virginia State Championships Heavy Equipment Competition 2024

Please refer to the most current SkillsUSA Technical Standards for a detailed description of guidelines and requirements. The scope of the contest will be drawn from these standards. NOTE: ALL contests are subject to increased difficulty levels from previous state competitions in order to align the scope and skill level to that of National Competitions.

The contest is not considered over until the area has been cleaned. Tear-down and removal is worth up to forty (40) points.

Contestants should report promptly at 7:45 to the contest site with their name tag turned so that their contestant number is showing.

Contestants must wear professional dress keeping with the SkillsUSA image and within recognized safety dress standards for the trade (Page 353).

Clothing Requirement: Official SkillsUSA khaki work shirt or SkillsUSA Virginia conference T-shirt, and pants or jeans; black, brown or tan leather work shoes; and safety glasses with side shields or goggles. (Prescription glasses can be used only if they are equipped with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles.)

Contestants must submit OSHA Certification and resume to the contest chair prior to the beginning of the contest:

- **Resumes, one page** go to www.vaskillsusa.org State Leadership Conference Announcements for Resume Worksheet; resume is worth 10% of the total contest score.
- OSHA card, certificate or letter verifying OSHA training
