Clothing

- Screwdrivers, assorted Flat Blade and Phillips Head
- Keyhole Saw
- Hack Saw
- Conduit Reamer
- Continuity Tester or VOM
- Fiberglass or Wooden step ladder (not to exceed 6 feet) (Optional)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ " EMT hand bender (no other benders or offset benders allowed)
- Drill bits both wood (1/2" & 7/8") and Metal (1/8" & ¼")
- Marker or Pencil
- NEC Code Book 2020 Edition
- OSHA Approved Safety Glasses
- Head Protection(Hard Hat)
- Work Gloves
- Foot Protection no open toe shoes or tennis shoes
- Cordless Battery Drill/Driver with extra Batteries (no power drill permitted)
