Theme: Fire & Ice

There will be a mandatory meeting for the advisors and contestants on Friday, April 4, 2025, in the seating section by the contest site. This will be the time for questions to be answered by the contest chairs. All Resumes will be submitted at this time.

Purpose

To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in Natural Hair Design and Braids by challenging students to be creative stylists and practice technical skills.

Contest Description

Contestants will demonstrate their artistic and creative abilities to create a Natural Hair Design.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to active SkillsUSA members enrolled in Cosmetology as the occupational objective.

Reminders

- Contestants should report a few minutes early to the contest site with their name tag turned so that their contestant number is showing.
- The contest is not considered over until the area has been cleaned.
- Contestants must submit Resumes, one page go to www.skillsusava.org State Leadership Conference Announcements for Resume Worksheet; the resume is worth 10% of the total contest score. Resumes should be turned in on Friday, April 19 during the contest orientation meeting.
- No cell phones or Flash Photography of any kind on the contest floor during the Contest (pictures and videos will be allowed after the contest).

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

White Dress Shirt with Black tie or Official SkillsUSA white polo shirt, black dress slacks, black socks, and black leather work or dress shoes or

White Dress Shirt or Official white polo top, black dress slacks or skirt, black socks, and black leather, work or dress shoes. Shoes should not exceed a 2-inch heel. These regulations refer to clothing items that are pictured and described at: www.skillsusastore.org. Note: Contestants must wear their official contest clothing to the contest orientation meeting. GENERAL CONTEST INFORMATION

- Manikins All participants must bring the required manikins for the competition.
 *See the manikin list for specific manikins for each contest.
- Contestant Notebook Contestants are to prepare a notebook to present to the Chairperson at orientation. Contents of the notebook should include:
 - Theme Fire & Ice Natural Hair / Braid Design.
 - **Sketch** An original hand-drawn sketch of your total concept should be framed and placed at your station.
- Items Not Allowed
 - Electric Stoves -- Contestants will be disqualified if this item is used.
 - Cell phones or other electronic devices are NOT allowed in the competition area.
- Talking No talking to other contestants, instructors, or audience members during the
 competition is allowed. Doing so may result in disqualification. If you have a question, raise
 your hand, and a sage or the competition chairperson will see to your needs.
- Breaks Breaks will be given during the competition. Contestants are not allowed to leave
 the area except with a chaperone for restroom visits or emergencies. If a contestant gets
 sick during the competition and needs to leave the contest area, no extra time will be
 allotted.
- Work Time You can begin the contest when the chairperson signals so and you must stop when time is called. Continuing to work will result in point deductions. All contestants must participate in all phases of the competition, including written (if applicable).
- Upon completion of the competition **DO NOT Remove Manikins** from the competition area until instructed to do so by the contest chairperson.
- Sanitation The contestant must disinfect and clean up their workstation/area, which

includes a total breakdown of their workstation/area. 1 Trash Bag is required, no labeling is needed. **THIS IS NOT STATE BOARD SANITATION** – Just what we are requiring for this competition. Sanitation for this contest includes –

- Sanitizing the workspace at the beginning,
- Sanitizing the workspace at the end,
- Items are not thrown on the floor throughout the competition, and
- All used items go in the trash bag.
- Secondary contestants will compete against secondary and postsecondary will only compete against postsecondary.
- JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL

- Burmax: (2)needed to choose from "Whitney, Yolanda, or Camila" (do not cut). *Manikin cannot be pre-sectioned.
- Two separate mankins are needed

- Manikin Stand/Holder Tripod
- 1 Large Trash Bag for soiled linens/towels and such, no labeling needed
- First aid kit
- KIT
 - Manikin stand
 - Hair ornaments and extensions
 - Hair product required for style, temporary only
 - Spray water bottle
 - Towels
 - Styling brushes, combs, hair/bobby pins, rubber bands etc.
 - All products to perform Braiding and style

Scope of the Contest -

Segment 1: Natural Hair Design – Braiding (Style Duplication) Whitney or Yolanda Manikin

- 1 hour, 30 minutes
- Whitney or Yolanda Manikin
- The contestant will duplicate a Natural Hair Braid design selected by the cosmetology technical committee.
- The finished style must resemble the picture preselected by the contest chairperson.
- Contestants must provide all working materials to complete the task.
- Complete cleaning and disinfection of the work area and prepare for the next segment.
- Judges will score only the finished look in this segment.

Segment 2: Natural Hair Design – Braiding (Creative Freestyle Design) Whitney, Yolanda or Camila

Theme: Fire & Ice

- 2 hours
- Whitney, Yolanda or Camila Manikin
- The contestant will perform Natural Hair Braiding Creative Freestyle Design.
- Include extensions.
- Contestants must provide all working materials to complete the design.
- The completed design must resemble the student-designed sketch.
- Ornaments, flowers, and hats will be allowed However, at least 2/3 of the model's hair must be visible (No more than 1/3 of the hair may be covered).
- Judges will score only the finished look in this section.
