Registration Types:

- Advisor** At least one advisor per school needs to be registered to submit the registration and generate an invoice. SkillsUSA Virginia does not charge for adult registrations for this event, however any advisor, administrator, chaperone, etc. that attends the event must have a **\$12** adult State Fair ticket.
- Contestant** Student contestants must be entered into the SkillsUSA Membership system and their membership must be Joined/Submitted, see indicator below. There is a **\$20** per contestant fee for the SkillsUSA Virginia State Fair Event in addition to the **\$8** State Fair student ticket. If your school is TPP, please contact James Harper, SkillsUSA Virginia Volunteer, jharper@skillsusava.org, 540-425-1980 (call/text) to set a time to register your students.
- Observer** Student observers must be registered for the event; however, they do not necessarily have to be entered into the SkillsUSA Membership system. There is no fee for student observers of the SkillsUSA Virginia State Fair Event, however they must have an **\$8** State Fair student ticket.

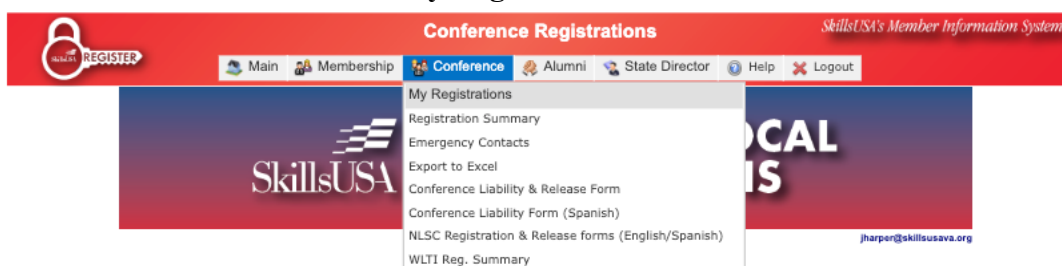

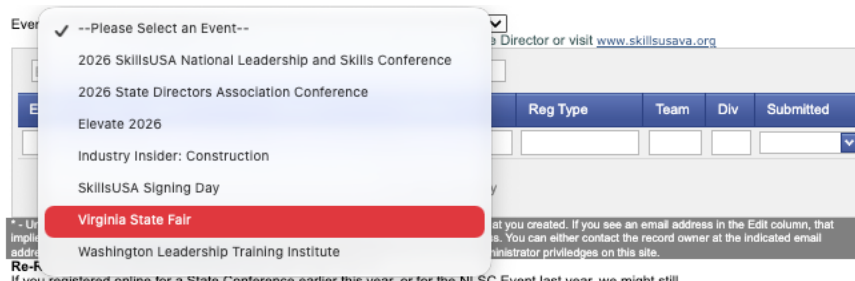

2026 SkillsUSA Virginia State Fair Registration Instructions:

1. Log in to the **SkillsUSA-Register** website: <https://www.skillsusa-register.org/Login.aspx>
2. Go to the **Conference** menu and select **My Registrations**:



3. Select the **Virginia State Fair** from the **Event:** drop down menu:



4. Click the **Add Registration** button. **NOTES:** If you want an estimate for your school, click the printer icon beside the **Fee Estimate** drop down menu to see an estimate of fees. Once all students and adults attending have been registered you click the **Submit Registration** button to finalize all event registrations and generate an invoice.

- Click **Save & Continue** button to finish entering required registrant data

ADDITIONAL NOTES: Some contests have limits on the number of contestants per school and on the total number of stations/contestants allowed to register. Please review the contest information posted on SkillsUSA Virginia website for those restrictions. If you want your contestant or team considered for a contest that has reached the limits set in the system, please register them for one of the contests starting with **WAIT LIST - S2x - <name of contest>**. We will review the registration data after registration closes on September 11th; to determine how many spots are left to fill and fill them using the Wait List contests registrations. We will contact the schools to let them know by end of business Monday, September 14th and adjust invoices as needed.
